<b>Allegation Description</b>	<p><b>Estimated Casualties – Killed: 3+, Injured: 3+</b></p> <p><b>Source #1:</b>  <b>May 19th 2017: (I550) النجار Najjar neighborhood, West Mosul, Nineveh province, Iraq</b>                      Summary: Two local sources reported that an <b>entire family was killed and another family was severely injured</b> as a result of <b>airstrikes on their houses in Najjar neighborhood</b>, in West Mosul. Iraqyoon Agency reported that the entire family of Nashwan Salem was killed in airstrikes that <b>hit their house near Saada area, in Najjar neighborhood</b>. It is unclear what the exact death toll is. Sawlf Ateka (local Facebook group) launched an appeal to help the family of Osama Anis. <b>Their house “behind the Bahaa al-Din Mosque” was hit by airstrikes</b>, and the family is in danger. They were pulled from the rubble, but are “seriously injured and are currently in a house in Khuz Bakr behind Baha al-Din Mosque.”                      Civilians reported <b>killed: 3 or more</b> (one entire family)                      Civilians reported <b>injured: 3 or more</b>                      Sources: Sawlf Ateka (Facebook) [Arabic] [Archived], Sawlf Ateka (Facebook) (2) [Arabic] [Archived], Iraqyoon Agency [Arabic] [Archived],  <b>Quality of reporting: Contested</b> – unclear who was responsible</p>
